Saturday, October 30	9am - 9pm
Sunday, October 31	9am - 7 pm

- ✓ Attend a mandatory, paid training seminar

Commitment:

General Election Poll Workers must be able to work Tuesday, November 2, 2021 from 5:15am until the close of the polls at 8:00pm.

General Election Poll workers must attend a mandatory, paid, training session. It is important all poll workers attend at least one training session to receive training on the new Electronic Poll Books.
